WHEREAS the Chief and Council of the Pabineau First Nation are interested in developing economic development opportunities for the Pabineau First Nation community; and


WHEREAS the Chief and Council desire to see the Pabineau First Nation community businesses flourish and become economically viable and self-sustaining; and


WHEREAS the Chief and Council are interested in establishing a blueberry cultivation and marketing business within the Pabineau First Nation community; and


WHEREAS the Chief and Council have completed a Pabineau Blueberry Cultivation and Marketing business plan that examines, in detail, the viability of this business opportunity;
