Re: "Non-Member Residency and Band Council Service Delivery Policy"


Whereas the crime rate on the Pabineau First Nation has been steadily escalating in recent years, and


Whereas numerous members and entire families of the Pabineau First Nation have requested the proactive support and engagement of the Chief and Council to actively reduce the crime rate of the Pabineau First Nation, and


Whereas members and entire families of the Pabineau First Nation have requested the proactive support and engagement of the Chief and Council to protect our borders from undesirable non-members who have characteristically engaged themselves in criminal activity,

Be It Resolved that we, the Chief and Council of the Pabineau First Nation, reserve the right to revoke the residency rights and evict any non-band member who possesses a criminal record, or who has characteristically been engaged in criminal activity, and

Be It Further Resolved that we, the Chief and Council of the Pabineau First Nation, reserve the right to restrict or entirely exclude any non-member resident who possesses a criminal record, or who has characteristically been engaged in criminal activity, from access to any social or community services offered within the community, including social assistance, rental assistance, health care, educational support, student transportation, employment, etc.,.
