WHEREAS the Chief and Council of the Pabineau First Nation are interested in developing economic development opportunities for the Pabineau First Nation community; and


WHEREAS the Chief and Council desire to see the Pabineau First Nation community businesses flourish and become an economically viable and self-sustaining; and


WHEREAS the Chief and Council are interested in establishing a seafood market within the Pabineau First Nation community; and
