Re: Transfer of Student Information from District to First Nation

WHEREAS the Pabineau First Nation Chief and Council held a duly convened Band Council meeting on November 30, 2010, 2010; and

WHEREAS the Chief and Council of the Pabineau First Nation have endorsed the Memorandum of Understanding: regarding education and First Nation students and communities in the Province of New Brunswick; and

WHEREAS the Chief and Council of the Pabineau First Nation have signed an Enhanced Program and Services Agreement on Primary and Secondary Education and as a result have formed District Aboriginal Education Enhancement Committees to identify priorities and to resource these priorities based on budget and committee consensus; and

WHEREAS the Chief and Council have endorsed through consultation with their appointed Board of Director of F.N.E.I.I., the purchase of the student tracking system, Dadavan, as part of the First Nation Student Success Program; and

WHEREAS Dadavan, a company based out of Nova Scotia has been selected because of their work with MK in Nova Scotia and have been highly acclaimed because of the reporting templates that have been developed, which meet the requirements of all of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada's reporting forms and reporting templates; and


WHEREAS the Chief and Council of the Pabineau First Nation have designated the Directors of Education to work with F.N.E.I.I., to set up the student tracking system, through Dadavan, which requires each community to set up a student database and which involves acquiring information on each student member of the Pabineau First Nation, who are registered in K4 to grade 12, as well as, for those attending post-secondary education institutions; and


WHEREAS the Chief and Council of the Pabineau First Nation understands that the information required to populate the fields in the Dadavan system is managed by the local District,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Chief and Council request that the information held by the school District supporting the development of a student tracking system be released to Barbara Calderone, the Director of Education, in order to complete the student tracking system for the Pabineau First Nation.
