the hours of 11am to 1pm.

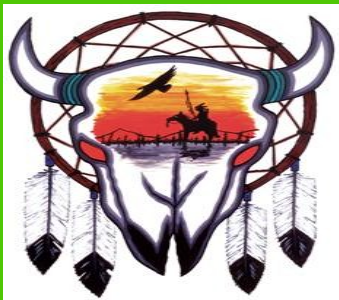
